

New Appointee FPPE Plan: OB/GYN Form – SAMPLE

Proctoring Cognitive Care

Retrospective (20 cases, including the following types – OB and GYN)

Obstetrics

- Management of normal labor, delivery, and after care
- Management of premature labor/PROM<36 weeks
- Management of preeclampsia/eclampsia
- Management of ectopic pregnancy
- Management of post-partum complications

GYN

If practitioner does not practice obstetrics, then 20 cases, including the following types

- Management of injuries, diseases, or disorders of the gynecologic system
- Nonsurgical management of injuries or disorders of the mammary glands
- Management of incontinence/stress incontinence

Proctoring Procedural Care

Retrospective (three cases involving the following types of procedures)

Obstetrics

- Cesarean section
- Operative vaginal deliveries
- Shoulder dystocia maneuvers
- Circumcision
- Repair of fourth-degree perineal lacerations
- GYN
- D&C
- Laparoscopic surgery
- Endoscopic procedures (e.g., hysteroscopy, cystoscopy)
- Laparotomy
- Robotic procedures (additional criteria may apply)

Ongoing Professional Practice Evaluation (OPPE)

Results compared to other OB/GYNs

360 Degree Evaluation

By proctors, consultants, anesthesia personnel and L&D nurses [perioperative personnel for GYNs]

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"Non-Routine Events" and/or Undesirable/Poor Outcomes

- o Incident reports
- o Event-related case reviews
- Unexpected adverse outcomes

Medical Record Reviews by Non-Licensed Independent Practitioners (LIPs)

By quality or other staff members

- Legibility/abbreviations
- Documentation completed timely
- o Complications
- o Infection rate
- Daily post-partum rounds
- H&P completed in a timely manner
- o Discharge summary completed in a timely manner
- Readmission within 72 hours of discharge
